# A hungry world on the move: the impact of the food crisis on migration and how we must respond

**13-14 October 2022**

(with departure on 15 October for in-person guests)

*Participants and observers are reminded of the private and confidential basis on which Ditchley Foundation conferences are held. All those participating do so in their personal capacities, not as spokespeople for any country or institution. In addition, all the proceedings take place under the 'Ditchley Rule', whereby all contributions are unattributable and interventions are made in strict confidence; this also applies to exchanges that take place outside the formal sessions. Those present are free to draw afterwards on the substance of what has been said, but not under any circumstances to reveal to any person not participating in the conference who it was that said it. The Rule will be scrupulously observed in any Note later produced on the conference by the Director. The verbal discussions will **not** be recorded, and private Zoom chats are, by definition, private. Public Zoom chats (i.e. chats sent to 'Everyone') will be saved, as any substantive comments may contribute to a conference summary (while adhering strictly to the Ditchley Rule).*
